

## Cost estimate of Election Campaign Proposal

Short title: Green Homes Tax Credit

Description: Creating a refundable Green Homes Tax Credit for homeowners to help pay

for energy-saving renovations for tax year 2020 and 2021. Homeowners will be eligible to receive a 20 percent refundable income tax credit for green improvements to their home of over \$1,000 and up to \$20,000; for a

maximum benefit of \$3,800 each tax year.

Estimation and The estimate is based on results from SPSD/M¹ (version 27.1). The estimation projection method: from SPSD/M assumed expenses were claimed in the same year incurred and

from SPSD/M assumed expenses were claimed in the same year incurred and claimed by only one member of the household. It was adjusted by the average ratio between SPSD/M modeling of a similar refundable tax credit previously offered in Quebec, RénoVert Tax Credit, and reported tax expenditure estimates and projections. The tax year costs were adjusted to reflect fiscal

year costs.

Uncertainty The estimate has moderate uncertainty. The list of approved eco-friendly assessment: eligible renovations will impact the cost estimate. The estimate is sensitive to

program uptake. The estimate may overstate the cost as it does not account for the behaviour response, as was the case for Quebec residents who had access to the RénoVert Tax Credit for work under a contract entered into after

March 17, 2016, and before April 1, 2019.
